Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by the Section Chair, Raymond Bilecky, at 10:06 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

Action: James Lee moved that the May 13, 2010 meeting minutes be approved as submitted. Sam Coppoletti seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Executive Director Report

- The Executive Director reported that there was no reason why Board spending for Fiscal Year 2011 should not come under the appropriation authority of \$900,000.
- The Executive Director reported that the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 budget requests are due to the Office of Budget and Management by November 1, 2010.
- The Executive Director informed the Section that the athletic trainer's renewals have been mailed.
- The Executive Director reported that the occupational therapy assistant renewal has been completed.
- The Executive Director reported that Senator Husted sponsored a bill authorizing non-Ohio licensed physicians traveling with a sports team to practice in the State of Ohio without an Ohio license. The Executive Director informed the Section that he will schedule a meeting with Senator Husted to discuss an amendment adding the physical therapy exemption language.

The formal Executive Director's report is attached to the minutes for reference.

Discussion of Law Changes

The Executive Director discussed the draft rules regarding confidential personal information. **Action:** Karen Holtgreffe moved that the Section file the confidential personal information rules. Sam Coppoletti seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The Section discussed, and supported, drafting rules that would eliminate the requirement for an individual to be licensed in the country of education. If the individual currently holds or has ever held a license in the individual's country of origin, a verification of licensure would be required.

Raymond Bilecky briefly discussed the Citizen Advocacy Center Conference agenda. Mr. Bilecky noted that FSBPT staff is scheduled to present at the conference.

If not, you may review them now.

In lieu of a stenographic record being made, let the minutes reflect the original sworn affidavit and exhibits shall be kept as the official record of the proceedings in the aforementioned matters in the Board office.

I will now recognize Assistant Attorney General, Yvonne Tertel, for the purpose of providing a brief synopsis of the case.

Correspondence

The Section reviewed the correspondence received by the Board and instructed the staff to send responses. The letters and responses are on file with the Board.

1. **Linda Wurm:** Ms. Wurm asked the Section questions regarding supervising unlicensed physical therapy personnel and asked if the maintenance programs, as shown by the attached forms, are legal for physical therapists to establish and monitor.
2. **William Benoit:** Mr. Benoit asked the Section whether physical therapist assistants may document a FIM score in medical records based on their observations.
3. **Paul Boys:** Mr. Boys asked the Section questions regarding billing for treatment by an aide and by an athletic trainer.
4. **Angie Curtis:** Ms. Curtis asked the Section questions regarding whether physical therapists are required to meet certain requirements/certification prior to performing dry needling.
5. **Bridget DeMattio:** Ms. DeMattio asked the Section for clarification regarding the direct access laws in regards to providing physical therapy school-based services for a child who does not have a physician.
6. **Diane Crecelius:** Ms. Crecelius asked the Section whether a physical therapist assistant may transpose new goals onto a goal page in the chart, based on the scenario provided.
7. **Cindy Ceroky:** Ms. Ceroky asked the Section for clarification on a physical therapist's role in treating wound care.
8. **Jennifer Schoen:** Ms. Schoen asked the Section whether a physical therapist assistant may do home visits with a resident.
9. **Marjoire Green:** Ms. Green asked the Section questions regarding accepting physician telephone orders in a hospital based setting.
10. **Charles Kay:** Mr. Kay asked the Section questions regarding supervision requirements for physical therapist assistants when treating Medicare/Medicaid clients.

New Business

Newsletter Update

The Section discussed potential topics for the newsletter, including: license verifications, elimination of pocket identification cards, Kimberly Payne's article on her trip to Haiti, rules changes, FAQ/hot topics from correspondence, IEP and the plan of care, continuing competence, and verifying Ohio approval numbers prior to licensure expiration date.

Ohio Physical Therapy Association (OPTA) Report

- Katie Rogers reported that the OPTA will host a booth at the Ohio State Fair on July 31, 2010 and August 1, 2010 and sponsor the 5 Mile run at the Ohio State Fair on August 1, 2010.
- OPTA invited the Physical Therapy Section to give a five minute Board update at the annual OPTA membership meeting in October.
- The OPTA Financial Report for continuing education applications reviewed in 2009 was distributed to the Section for review.

Federation of State Boards for Physical Therapy (FSBPT) Report

Raymond Bilecky distributed a proposed motion for Ohio to sponsor at this year's delegate assembly. The Physical Therapy Section supports the proposed language. Mr. Bilecky further reported to that FSBPT will conduct elections at the annual meeting this October. The Section will review the detailed election/candidate profiles, as well as the proposed delegate assembly motions, at the September meeting.

FSBPT sent out a press release announcing that it is temporarily suspending graduates from entry-level physical therapy programs in Egypt, India, Pakistan, and the Philippines from sitting for the National Physical Therapy Examination due to security breaches. The FSBPT is currently developing the NPTE-YRLY examination that will be offered to graduates from the impacted countries once per year. The estimated completion date for this new examination is the fall of 2011. The Section discussed how to handle applications from individuals who are impacted by this restriction. The Section currently has approximately 11 applications that fall in this category. The Section will hold these applications open until the NPTE-YRLY is available. In addition, if the Board receives an application from a graduate from one of the impacted countries, the applicant will be given the option of having the Board return the application without depositing the payment or processing the application with the understanding that the individual will not be eligible to sit until the fall of 2011.
