COURT MANDATORY REPORTING FORM

Required by section 2925.38 of the Ohio Revised Code

If a person who is convicted of or pleads guilty to a violation of section 2925.02, 2925.03, 2925.04, 2925.041, 2925.05, 2925.06, 2925.11, 2925.12, 2925.13, 2925.14, 2925.22, 2925.23, 2925.31, 2925.32, 2925.36, or 2925.37 of the Revised Code is a professionally licensed person, in addition to any other sanctions imposed for the violation, the court, except as otherwise provided in this section, immediately shall transmit a certified copy of the judgment entry of conviction to the regulatory or licensing board or agency that has the administrative authority to suspend or revoke the offender's professional license.

The above cited section of the Ohio Revised Code mandates Courts to report the following to the Ohio Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board:

Conviction of:

- a. any felony;
- b. any crime involving moral turpitude; or
- c. any misdemeanor committed during the course of practice.
