Discussion of Laws and Rules

The Council discussed extensively the creation of a new rule implementing the new authority to print open source 3-D prosthetics. There will be a workgroup including members of the council, the Ohio O & P Association, and individuals who conduct 3-D printing. The workgroup will seek input from the prosthetics field with the goal of having language for consideration at the November OTPTAT Board section meetings so the provision can be implemented per the language in the state budget bill, House Bill 166.

The Council also discussed the need for a change in the endorsement license statute in order to allow experienced orthotists and prosthetists who did not complete the O & P residency through NCOPE to practice in Ohio. The Executive Director will draft language for discussion at the next meeting.


Adjournment
