The affidavit contains the evidence and testimony upon which you will deliberate. Please take a few moments to review the evidence and testimony.

In lieu of a stenographic record being made, let the minutes reflect the original sworn affidavits and exhibits shall be kept as the official record of the proceedings in the aforementioned matter in the Board office.

I will now recognize Assistant Attorney General, Melissa Wilburn, for the purpose of providing a brief synopsis of these cases.

Ms. Wilburn reviewed the case for the Board.

Having heard Ms. Wilburn's synopsis, may I now have motion to admit the facts and exhibits outlined in the sworn affidavits in the aforementioned cases into evidence?

The Section went into private session at 10:40 a.m. and came out at 10:47 a.m. Chad Miller, James Lee, and Melissa Wilburn, AAG left the room during private session and did not participate in the deliberations.

In the matter of case number PT-17-078, Tina Marie McKinney, after review of the evidence the Board makes the following findings of fact:

1. The Board had jurisdiction to conduct a hearing in this matter pursuant to *Goldman v. State Medical Board of Ohio*, 110 Ohio App. 3d 124; 673 N.E.2d 677 (1996).
2. McKinney failed to provide proof of completion of the required twenty-four (24) hours of Ohio approved continuing education for the reporting period of February 1, 2014 to January 31, 2016.
3. McKinney did not request a hearing on the aforementioned charge.

In the matter of case number PT-17-078, Tina Marie McKinney, after review of the evidence, the Board makes the following conclusions of law:

1. McKinney was properly served with the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing pursuant to R.C. 119.07.
2. R.C. 119.07 required McKinney to request a hearing within thirty (30) days of the mailing of the Notice.
3. McKinney violated R.C. §§ 4755.47(A)(6) & (22) and 4755.51, and Ohio Admin. Code § 4755-23-08(E)(2).
