CE Broker

Licensees can use the system to store CE certificates of completion, and OPTA could upload CE approvals externally, CE providers could also use the system for tracking CE certificates. The OT Section is interested in using CE Broker to manage CE application approvals. The PT Section did not have any objections of moving forward with this process.

The Section allowed the students to ask questions.

Ohio Physical Therapy Association (OPTA) Report

Victoria Gresh reported that the upcoming OPTA events are Optimizing Conference and Leadership Academy. Ms. Gresh informed the Board that this year OPTA will have an Advocacy Day with the legislature. Victoria Gresh further reported that the update to the continuing education policies and procedures will be reviewed at the January 2019 OPTA Director's meeting. The changes reflect technology changes and the new process to apply for continuing education. OPTA is looking for alternatives to integrate the legislative platform in a friendlier mobile format.

Federation of State Boards for Physical Therapy (FSBPT) Report

Jennifer Wissinger gave a brief recap of the 2019 Annual Conference. The main topic address how provider burnout can lead to mistakes, issues, and enforcement. Also discussed were collecting data through MDS, by which each state would collect similar data. This data could be used get services to underserved populations, predict trends in gaps in service areas. Jennifer Wissinger also encouraged new board members the FSBPT new member orientation and training in June/July. The Executive Director reported that the Board is back to a Five Star Rating. The Section noted that Thomas Caldwell was re-elected to Secretary.
